Here at the Farm our Growers do a lot of Cooking, Crafting, Gardening and Animal activities daily. If you would like to provide items that will help us provide more of these meaningful activities here is a list of things we need.

If you want to donate items you don't see here, please feel free to call and check.

Things we always need:

- Paints; spray paints, acrylic paints, water color paints, and even outdoor paints
- Paper; construction paper, card stock, crafting paper or just colored paper
- Glue and tape; craft glue, tacky glue, wood glue, glue sticks, masking tape, scotch tape, and duct tape
- Kitchen utensils; forks and spoons, measuring spoons and cups
- Plastic ware; all sizes of plastic containers and lids, and plastic utensils
- Garden gloves, potting soil,

Special needs: (things we only need a small amount of, or seasonal items or items we need for a special project)

- Shoe boxes, Christmas wrapping paper and small gift items for Operation Christmas Child (October and November)
- Yard sale items; clothing, small appliances and household items (June)
- Special Seasonal Craft projects Call 717-298-1845 to find out what we are working on.

Large needs: (these can be the objective of a personal fundraising campaign)

- Vehicle Mini Van
- Water Treatment system upgrade
- New tires for the vehicles
- Chicken coop/aviary Fencing we need to expand the Aviary and yard area for the chickens
- Railroad ties for nature trail

<u>COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES</u>: We visit a lot of museums and recreational activities where we pay for most of the Growers' entrance fees. We go to movies, museums, farmers markets, and even yoga and art classes. If you would like to contribute to these events a <u>Visa Gift</u> <u>Card</u> would be very helpful.

<u>COOKING</u>: We do a lot of baking and creating recipes with the vegetables we grow here at the Farm. We also do a lot of canning of our produce for the Growers to take home and to make available to the public for donations. What would be helpful are <u>local grocery store</u> <u>gift cards</u>. We do a lot of our shopping at Weis and Giant stores.

<u>CRAFTING</u>: We have a lot of bits and pieces for the craft projects we do. We create note cards and craft items for the Growers to take home and we make some available to the public for donations. What would be helpful are <u>local craft or department store gift</u> <u>cards</u>. We do a lot of our shopping at Lowes, Michaels and Hobby Lobby.

<u>GARDENING</u>: We have over 40 raised garden beds, dozens of blueberry and raspberry bushes, and several different types of fruit trees, as well as hundreds of varieties of flowers all around the Farm. Our Growers learn how to care for all the plant and even start most of our vegartables from seeds over the winter in the greenhouse. What would be helpful are gift cards from <u>local home and gardening stores or nurseries</u>. We do a lot of shopping at Lowes, Home Depot, Stauffers of Kissell Hill, and Ashcombes.

<u>ANIMAL CARE AND THERAPY</u>: We have a several different types of farm animals the Growers are responsible to care for. Every day they feed, water, groom and exercise their horses, sheep, goats, pigs, chickens, alpacas, rabbits, and a guinea pig. What would be helpful are gift cards for *local farming supply stores*. We do most of our animal feed and supply shopping at Brant's, Agway and Tractor Supply.
